- Clara Castronova: "Hello I am the chapter chair for CALPIRG here at UCLA. Congratulations on being elected and having your first meeting. I am here to give you a brief update on what CALPIRG is doing. A quick overview for those of you who might not know but CALPIRG is an advocacy group on campus. We have chapters at all UC's.
